- □ Empyrean Application form: Please make sure all the information is correctly completed.
 - Please provide student's contact details i.e. phone number, email id and skype id.
 - Please ensure the student completes the form in his/her handwriting.
 - Signed declaration.
- □ Qualification:
 - Year 12 or equivalent completion certificate
 - Any recent academic transcript
- □ English prerequisite
 - o IELTS 5.5 or equivalent (please refer to Empyrean English requirement brochure)
 - English test is an option for onshore from Assessment Level 1 or 2 countries.
- □ Certified copy of passport (front and back page)
- □ Emergency contact detail
- □ Recent Curriculum Vitae
- □ Completed GTE Assessment Questionnaire with certified supporting documents.

Additional documents for International student already in Australia and planning to extend their visa onshore.

- □ Copy of OSHC
- □ Copy of visa
