Information for Job Providers and Referral Contacts

Eligibility Criteria:

1. Employed looking to gain further skills of formalise skills into a qualification
2. Unemployed with or with or without concession card
3. Persons over the age of 15
4. Persons under the age of 18 who have completed a valid Notice of Arrangement (NOA) or can produce exemption from school education documents. (Home School).
5. Spouses of subclass 457 visa's
6. Holders of temporary visa subclass 309, 820 or 826
7. Students with a valid USI number
8. Must be Australian resident

Financial Hardship Criteria: To be eligible for fee waiver all of the following criteria items MUST be met.

1. The student must have a Department of Human Services 'low income' health care card
2. The student does not have the disposable income to pay the fees via instalments without compromising their ability to meet basic living needs
3. There is no basis for concluding that the student's financial circumstances are likely to change within a reasonable period.

For students to be eligible for fee waiver due to hardship student must fill in Empyrean Financial Hardship form. Student must provide reasons for hardship and may need to supply proof of income documents to verify. Students whom apply for and are approved for financial hardship are subject to Empyreans Financial Hardship policy and procedure. **Verification email from Job seeker case officer is required to confirm the financial hardship application form.**
